PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE (PFC) AMENDMENTS Amending PFC 10-1 and PFC 12

On April 24, 2019, the Metropolitan Airports Commission (MAC) submitted a notice to airline carriers serving Minneapolis-St. Paul International (MSP) Airport regarding a meeting to discuss the above-mentioned PFC applications. The consultation meeting with the airlines was held on June 4, 2019.

In accordance with the requirements of 14CFR Part 158, Passenger Facility Charge program, the MAC is providing an opportunity for public comment on the above applications. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) authority is required to fund various projects at the MSP Airport.

Individuals wishing to comment on the proposed PFC applications will have 30 days to provide comments. The comment period ends on Monday, August 19, 2019.
