The new ASCEND program, launching early 2026, does just that by helping qualified businesses navigate the concessions application process and by setting aside certain opportunities, including some carts and vending, especially for these businesses.

WHO IS ASCEND FOR?

Small businesses who want to **operate a concession** at MSP International airport and have:

- Revenue of \$56.42 M or less (5 yr avg.)
- Personal net worth of \$2.047 M or less

Also, **ACDBE certified** businesses may be enrolled automatically. There are **no geographical limits**, **and no other criteria** based on background or status. See our site for full details!

HOW DOES ASCEND CERTIFICATION HELP?

ASCEND-certified companies will be eligible to submit proposals for specific **spaces and opportunities set aside for the program.** The administering office will ensure bonding and insurance costs are reasonable and help identify potential locations and partnerships. They will then evaluate proposals and select qualified vendors to fill the available opportunities.
