42 An Ordinance to promote and conserve the public safety, health, peace, convenience,
43 and welfare on properties owned by or under the supervision and control of the
44 Metropolitan Airports Commission; establishing rules of conduct and regulating the
45 activities of persons thereon; prohibiting the smoking of cannabis, hemp, and other
46 related products; providing the penalty for violations thereof.

47 The Metropolitan Airports Commission does ordain:

48 **Section 1 - Definitions.**

49 Artificially derived cannabinoid, cannabis flower, cannabis product, and hemp-derived
50 consumer product shall have the meanings as defined in Minn. Stat. § 342.01 (enacted
51 in Laws of Minnesota 2023, Chapter 63).

52
53 Commission means the Metropolitan Airports Commission, a public corporation
54 organized and operating under Minnesota Law.

55 Electronic delivery device means any product containing or delivering a substance
56 through inhalation of aerosol or vapor from the product.

57
58 Public place means property owned, leased, or controlled by a governmental unit and
59 private property that is regularly and frequently open to or made available for use by the
60 public in sufficient numbers to give clear notice of the property's current dedication to
61 public use.

62 Smoking means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted or heated product
63 that is intended for inhalation. Smoking includes using an electronic delivery device.

64 **Section 2 – Prohibition on Smoking**

65 On properties or in public places owned by or under the supervision and control of the
66 Commission, no person shall smoke any cannabis flower, cannabis product, artificially
67 derived cannabinoid, or hemp-derived consumer product.

68 **Section 3 – General Provisions.**

69 1. Penalty. Violation of this Ordinance is a petty misdemeanor. Anyone violating
70 this Ordinance may be removed from Commission property.

71 2. Provisions Severable. If any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held
72 unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the
73 remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Commission hereby declares it would
74 have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance if it had known that such part
75 or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

76 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect on January 1,
77 2024.
