

Summer Internship Program

The Metropolitan Airport Commission Internship Program is a 12-week summer program for college students beginning in June and ending in mid-August. **Internships are full-time and paid \$24 to \$25 per hour.**

- High-quality, resume-building work experience and career development
- Exposure to the Metropolitan Airport Commission and the aviation industry

2026 Internship Departments

Airside Operations ensures the safe, secure, and efficient movement of aircraft on the airfield.

Community Relations works to foster positive relationships with surrounding communities by monitoring and evaluating aircraft noise data, investigating noise complaints, and addressing community members' concerns.

Customer Data & Analytics gathers and analyzes passenger feedback and behavior to improve the airport experience by conducting survey research, data visualization, and disseminating findings.

Financial Analysis & Planning develops budgets, forecasts revenues and expenses, benchmarks trends, and analyzes data to support the airport's strategic decision-making.

Information Security

protects the airport's digital infrastructure by managing security risks, monitoring for systems threats, and ensuring compliance with data protection standards.

Internal Audit ensures financial integrity, compliance with laws and regulations, and operational efficiency by conducting independent and objective evaluations.

Legal Affairs provides legal guidance, ensures compliance with laws and regulations, drafts and reviews contracts, supports policy development, and represents the airport in legal matters.

Social Media and Digital Marketing

promotes the airport's brand and services by creating engaging content, managing online platforms, and analyzing digital trends to connect with travelers and the community.

Stakeholder Engagement connects the airport to the community by hosting engagement events and serving as the organization's connection across communities and within the organization.

Sustainability operationalizes the airport's sustainability goals through hands-on projects and research, including waste audits, energy data analysis, and community engagement to promote environmentally responsible operations.

Terminal Operations ensures smooth airport operations by managing shared resources, coordinating maintenance and emergencies, and facilitating communication among airlines, ground staff, and stakeholders.
