1. ROLL CALL

Rebecca Townsend, JAZB Secretary, took roll call.

2. WELCOME AND AGENDA OVERVIEW

Lydia Werner, Airport Planner for MAC, welcomed the board members and oriented them to the agenda.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM NOVEMBER 16 MEETING

Chair Rick Weyrauch asked if everyone had had a chance to review the minutes from last meeting, then entertained a motion.
