Additional Suggestions
Fall 2018 NOC Work
Plan:

- Produce annual reports on 55dB (~~just~~ just to have data)
- Set goals to reduce Nighttime Flights / Noise
- Produce Comparative Reports on MSP vs. other benchmark / leader airports that look at noise reductions and rank MSP
- Reorganize NOC membership to include:
 - At-Large Rep for Edina / St. Louis Park (our issues are not effectively represented)
 - Reduce / Combine industry Reps
 - Add a rep for "Resident at-large"
