**METROPOLITAN AIRPORTS COMMISSION
ORDINANCE No. 92**

An Ordinance to promote and conserve the public safety, health, peace, convenience and welfare; to facilitate Airport expansion; to rename Airport gates and concourses using the alpha-numeric system used at most airports.

WHEREAS, concourses at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, Charles A. Lindbergh Terminal, are currently named Green, Blue, Red and Gold; and

WHEREAS, such concourses are being renamed Concourses A-G respectively; and

WHEREAS, airline gates on each concourse are also being renumbered.

NOW THEREFORE, the Metropolitan Airports Commission does ordain:

SECTION 1 – DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 Airport. Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport located in Hennepin County, Minnesota.
- 1.2 Commission. The Metropolitan Airports Commission, a public corporation organized and operating pursuant to Chapter 500, Laws of Minnesota 1943 and amendments thereto.
- 1.3 Document. Any lease, contract, agreement, law, statute, ordinance, construction document, blueprint, memorandum, or any other document of any nature that references the Terminal, concourses, gates or any other area governed by this Ordinance.
- 1.4 Executive Director. The Commission's chief executive officer or a designated representative.
- 1.5 Terminal. Charles A. Lindbergh Terminal, including all concourses, at the Airport.

SECTION 2 – REDESIGNATION

2.1 Concourse Renaming

A. Green Concourse becomes Concourses A-D

The Green Concourse shall be renamed Concourses C and D as shown on Exhibits 1, 2, and 3, with planned expansion to the east to be called Concourses A and B.

B. Blue Concourse becomes Concourse E

The Blue Concourse shall be renamed Concourse E as shown on Exhibits 1 and 3.

C. Red Concourse becomes Concourse F

The Red Concourse shall be renamed Concourse F as shown on Exhibits 1 and 4.

D. Gold Concourse becomes Concourse G

The Gold Concourse shall be renamed Concourse G as shown on Exhibits 1 and 5.

2.2 Gate Renumbering

The gates shall be renumbered from the existing numbering to the letters/numbers shown on Exhibits 1-5.

2.3 Areas not Shown on Exhibits

The Executive Director has the authority to designate the names/numbers of any areas not specifically designated by this Ordinance.

2.4 Future Changes

Nothing in this Ordinance precludes the Commission or the Executive Director from making any future changes to the Airport or the Terminal. This includes, but is not limited to, changing areas designated by this Ordinance without requiring amendment of such Ordinance.

SECTION 3 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

3.1 Enforcement

Violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor as set forth in Minn. Stat. § 473.608, subd. 17(1), or as may be amended. The penalties prescribed under this Ordinance in no way preclude the Commission from taking any other civil action authorized by law.

3.2 Provisions Severable

If any part or parts of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, this does not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Commission declares it would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance without the unenforceable provisions.

3.3 Effective Date

This Ordinance is effective September 1, 2000.
