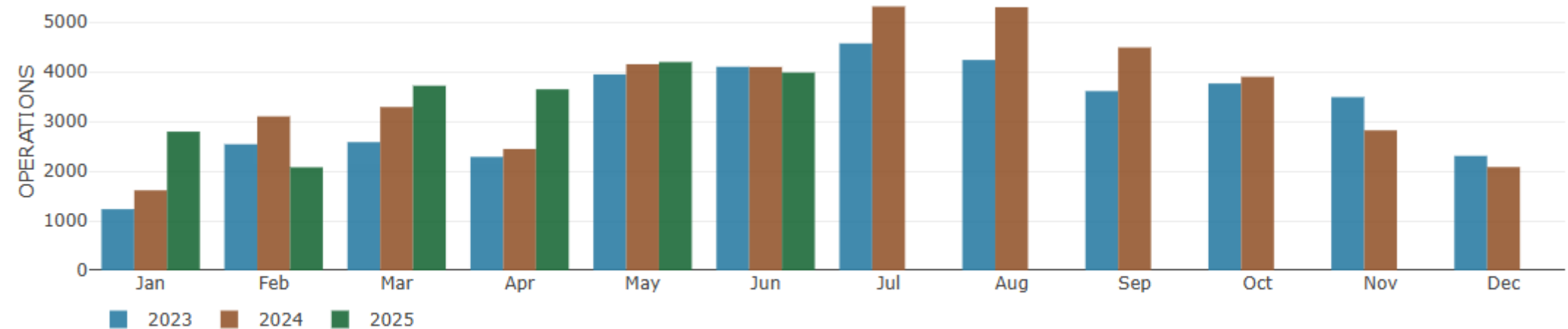

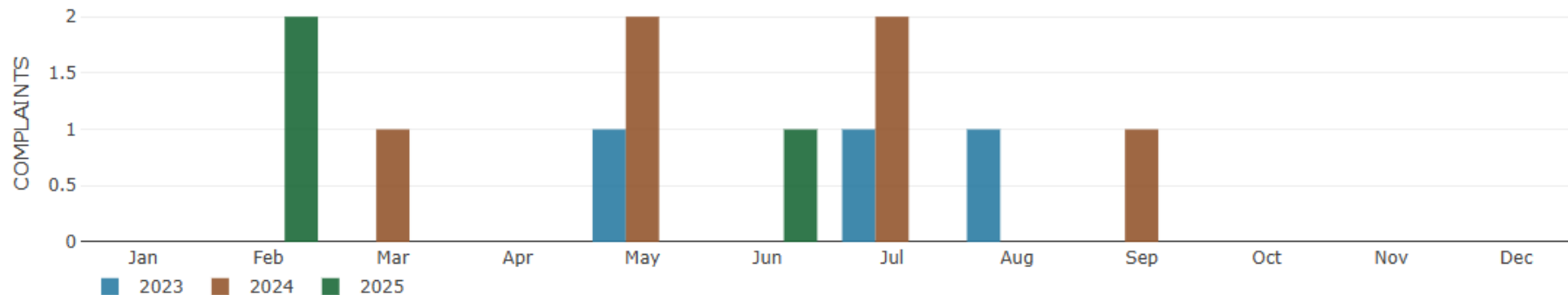
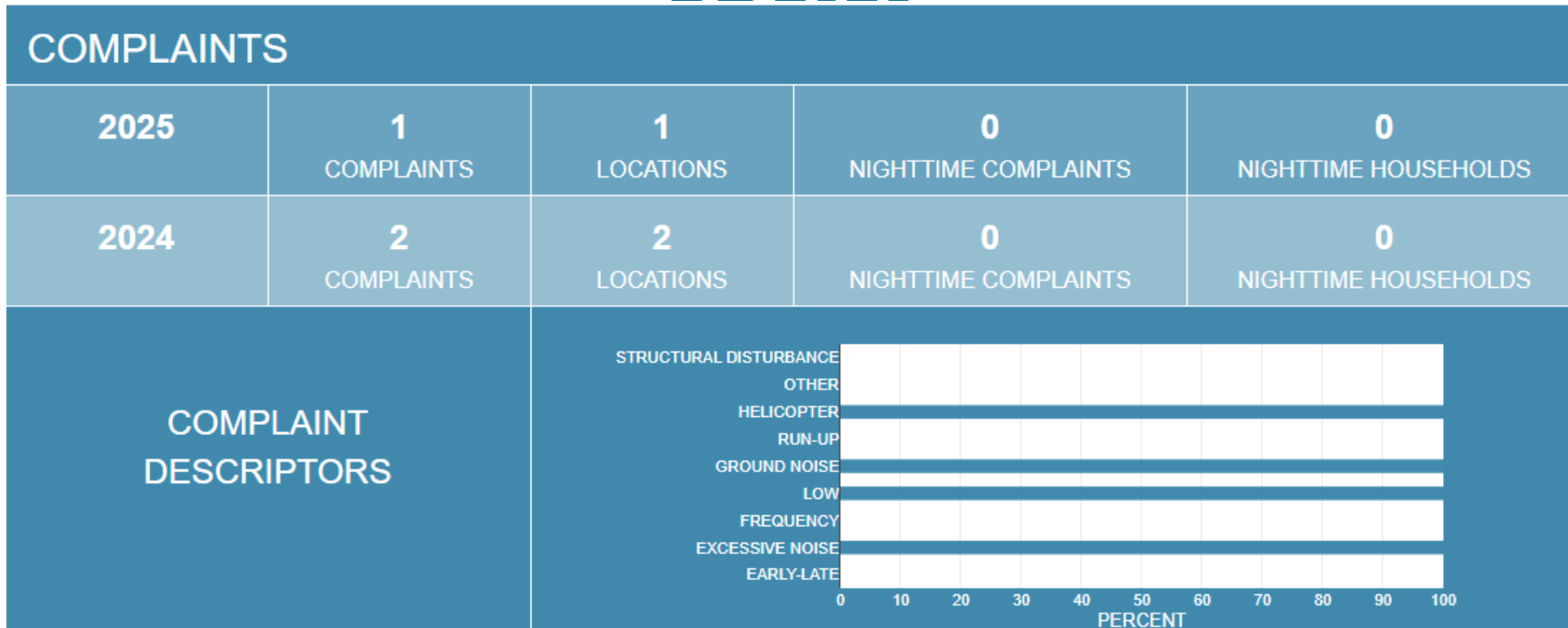
LVN Aircraft Noise Complaints

2Q 2025

- ✓ Complaints are used for analysis purposes only.
- ✓ Complaint information received through a 24-hour hotline, website account, email, and in-person.
- ✓ Complaints are correlated to flight tracking data (MACNOMS) using details provided by the customer.
- ✓ Responses to complaints are as requested.
- ✓ Aircraft operations counts are based on MACNOMS data.

FAA MOSAIC FINAL RULE

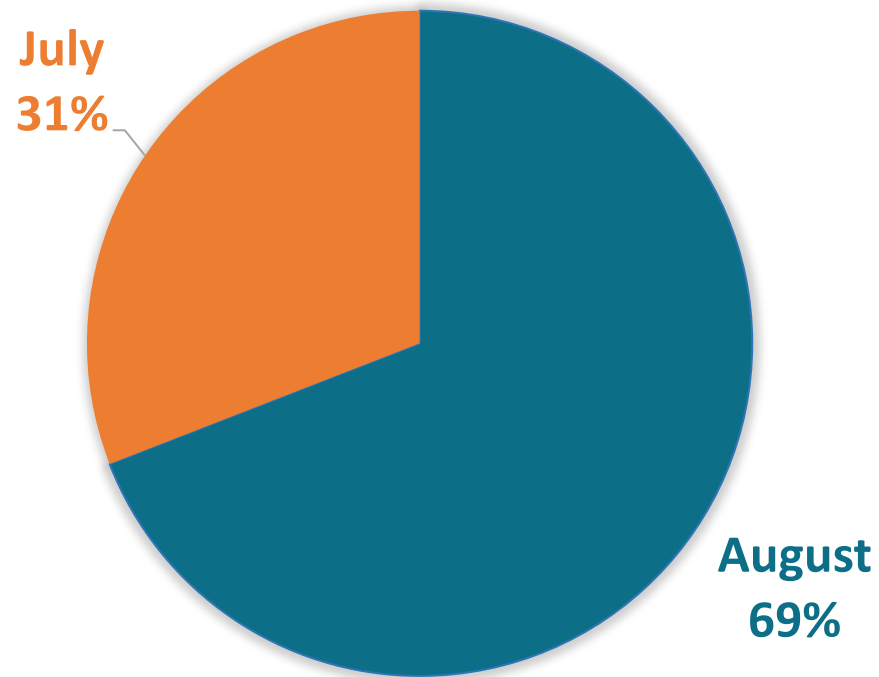
- The FAA Modernization of Special Airworthiness Certification (MOSAIC)
- Significantly expands the Light Sport Aircraft (LSA) category by:
 - increasing aircraft performance limits (like speed and weight),
 - allowing four-seat aircraft,
 - Permitting new technologies such as turbines and retractable landing gear.
 - This rule also expands privileges for sport pilots, enabling them to fly a broader range of aircraft and perform new aerial work, making flying more accessible and versatile.
- The final rule was announced in July 2025 and updates the regulations first established in 2004



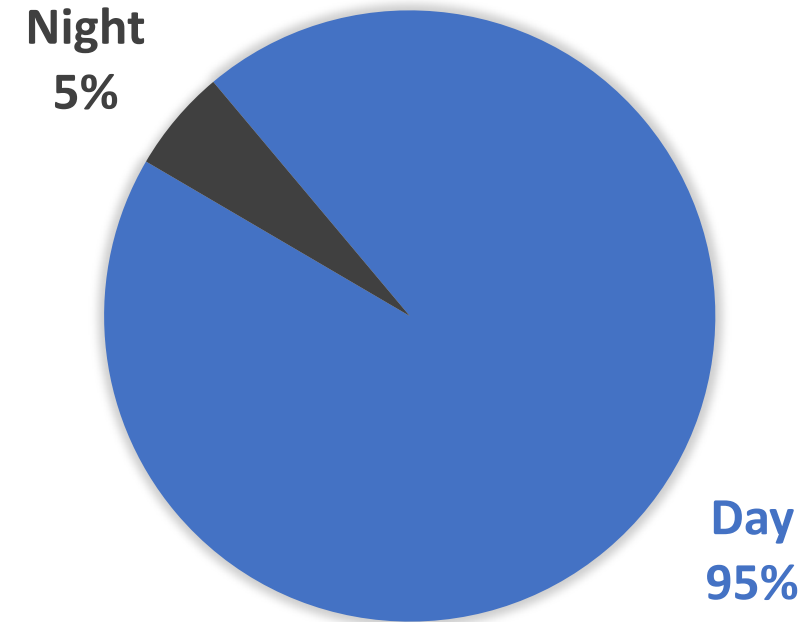


Non-Local Training Flights
