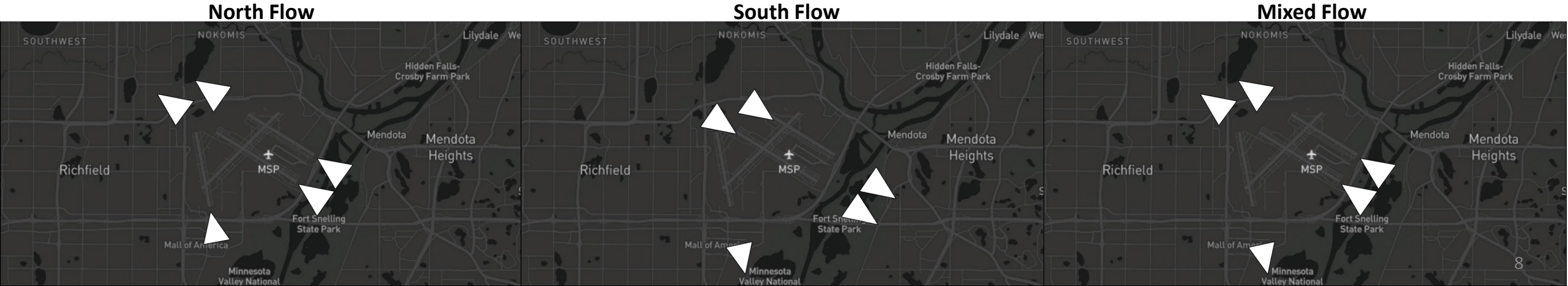

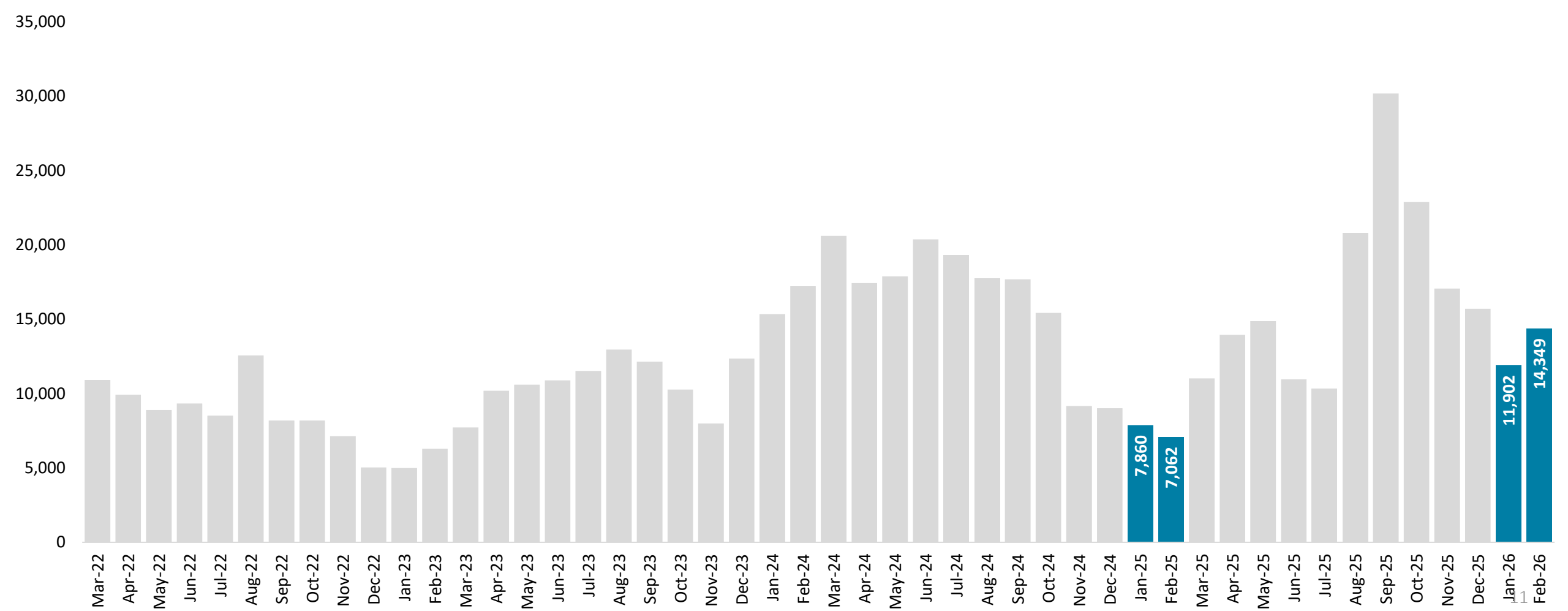
CARRIER JET FLEET MIX

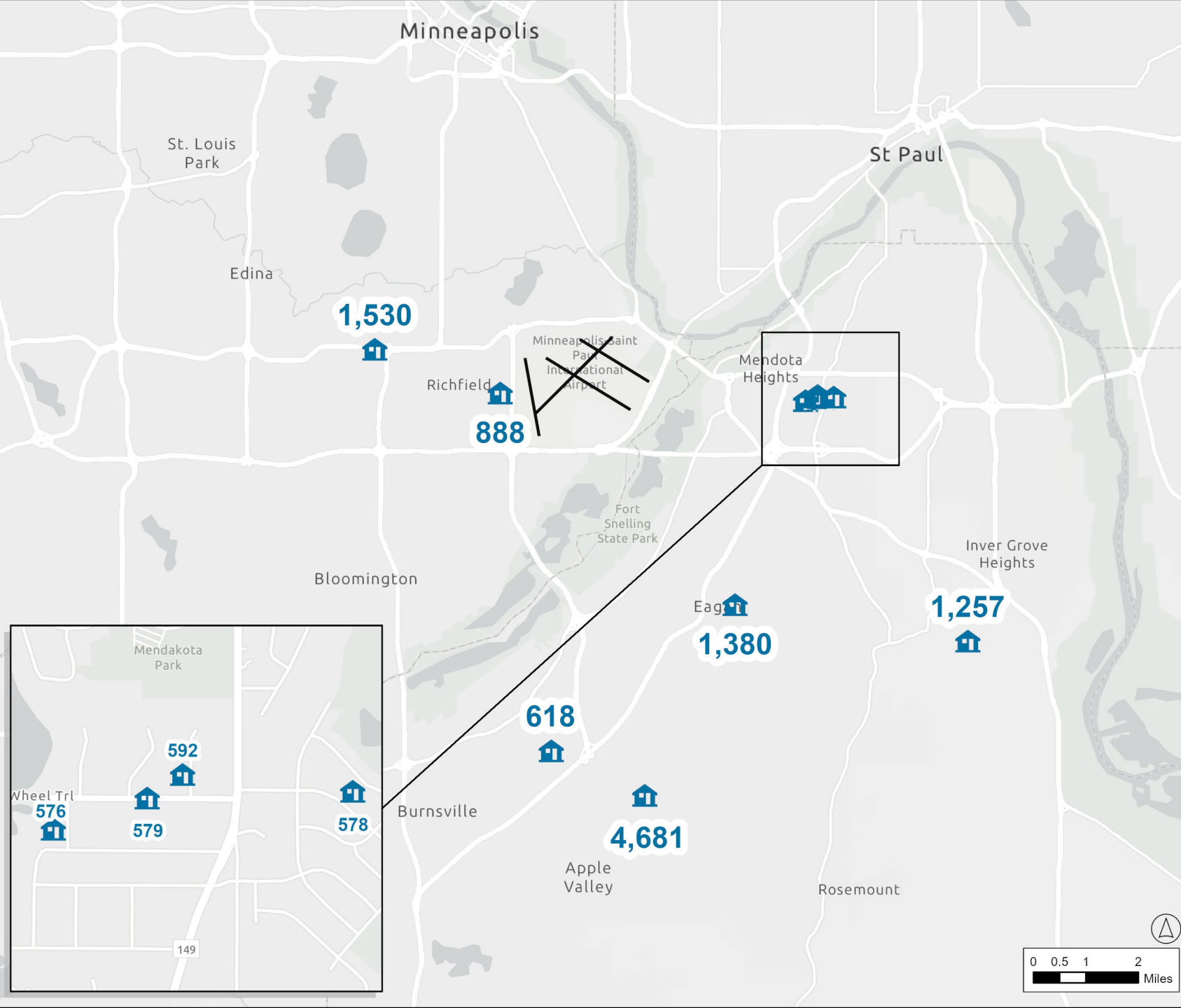

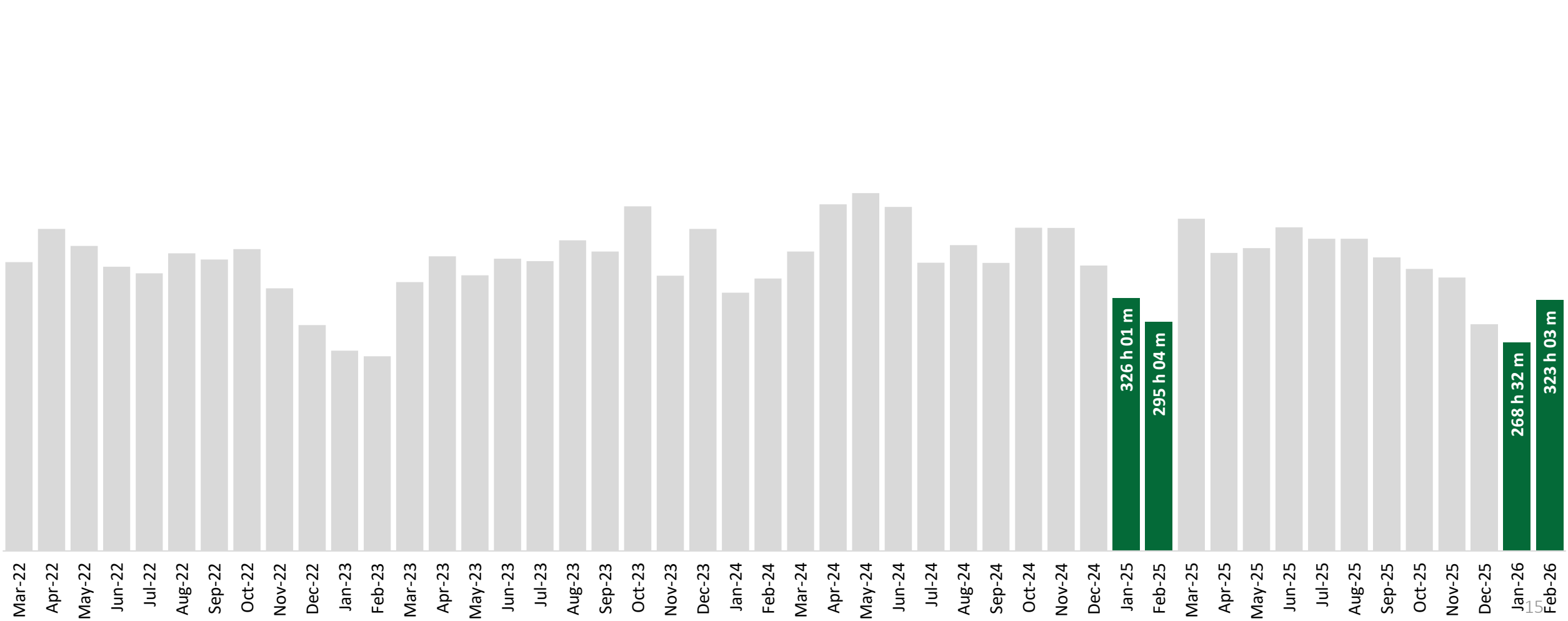

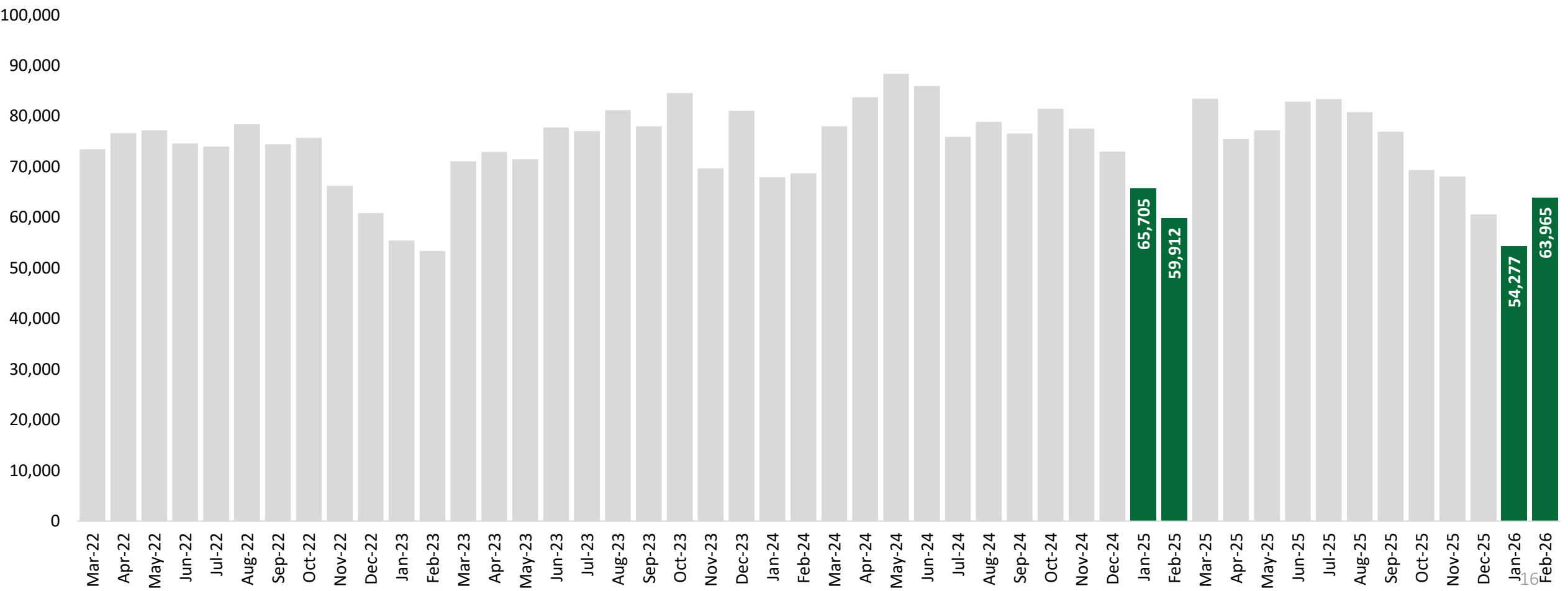

MSP 2025 Annual Contour Report Overview

- The amended Consent Decree requires the MAC to prepare an annual noise contour analysis for MSP by March 1st of each year.
- The 2025 MSP Annual Noise Contour Report was developed using the Aviation Environmental Design Tool (AEDT) v.3g.
- On February 27th the MAC published the 19th Annual Noise Contour Report consistent with the requirements in the Consent Decree.

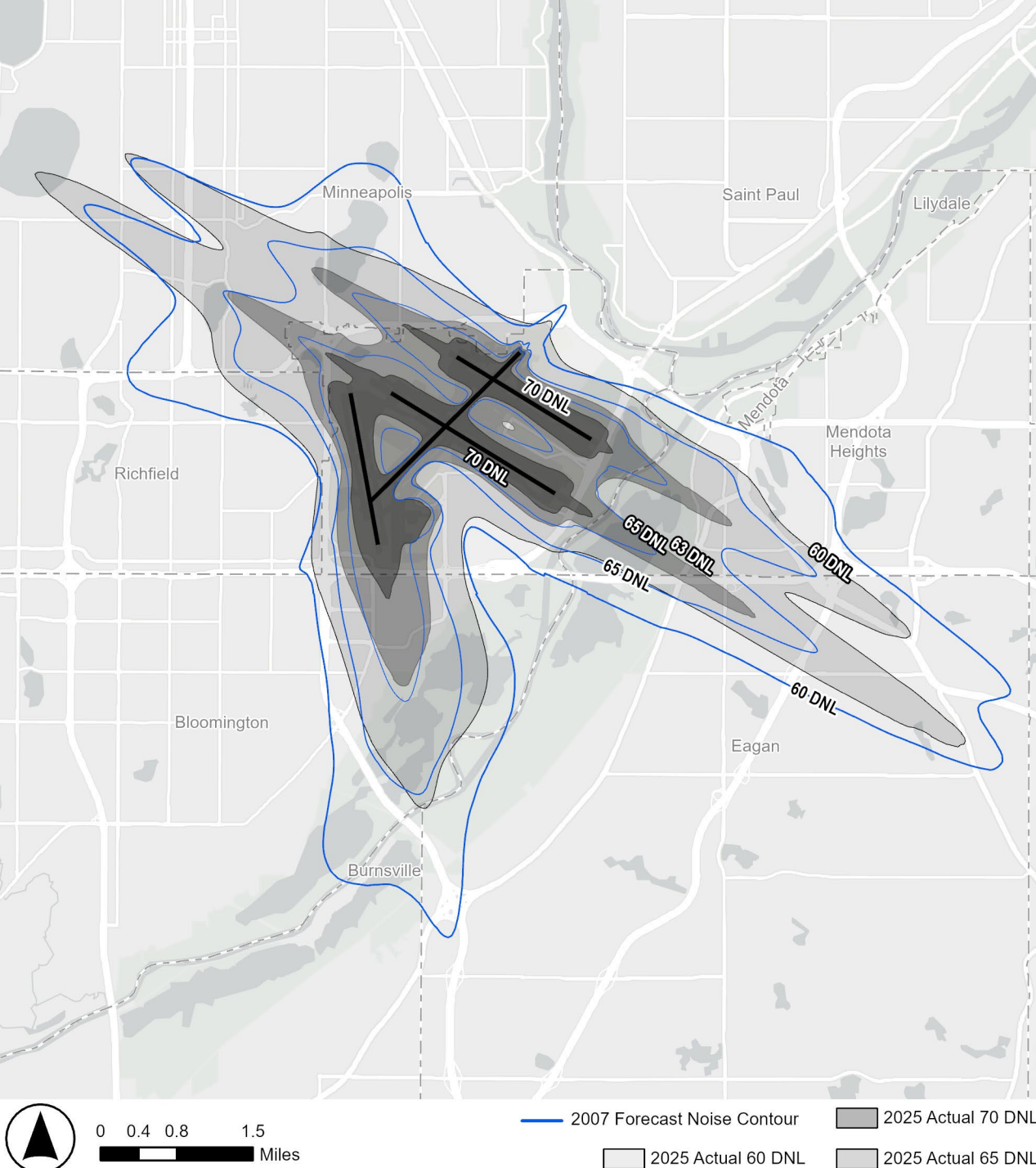

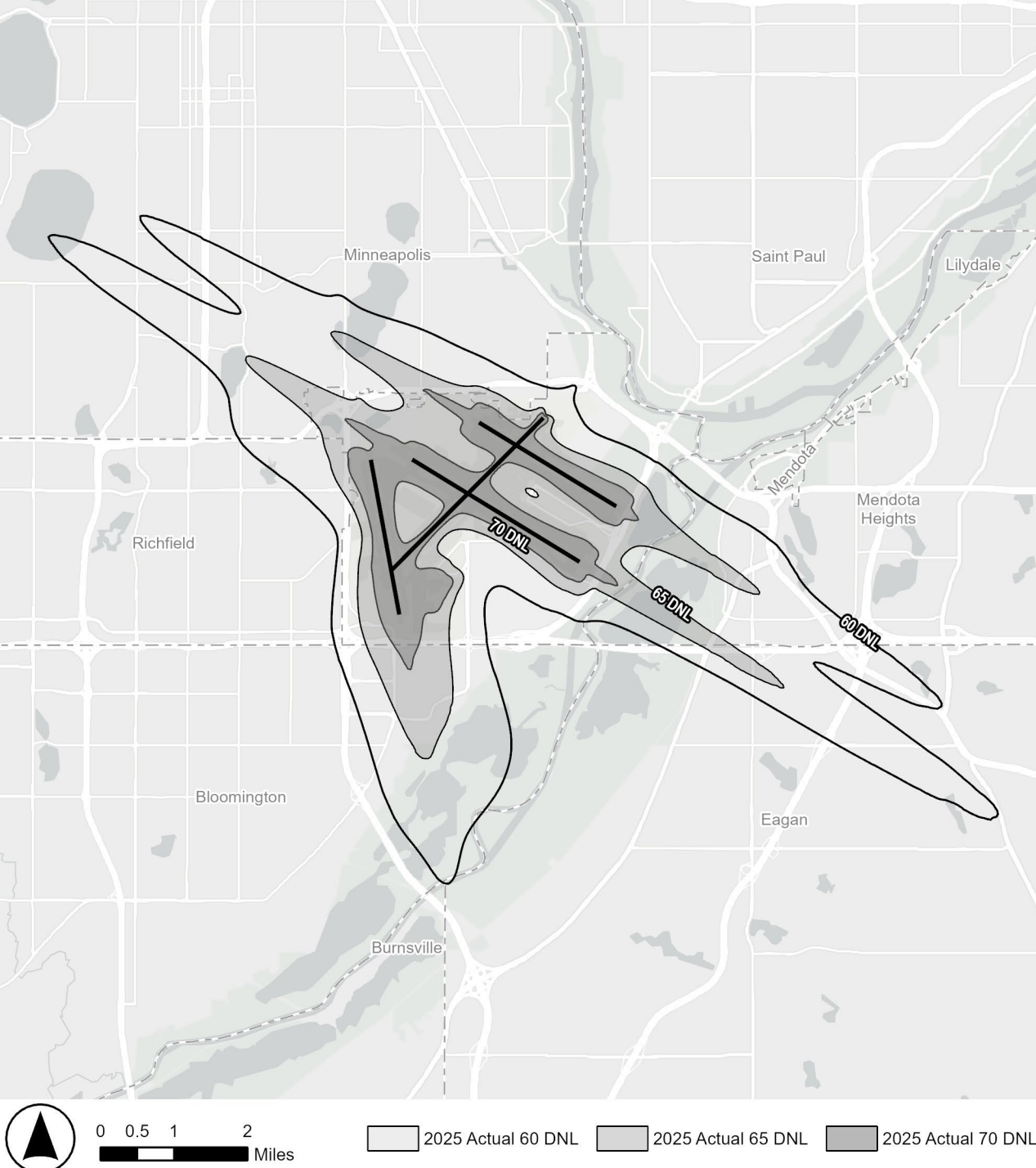

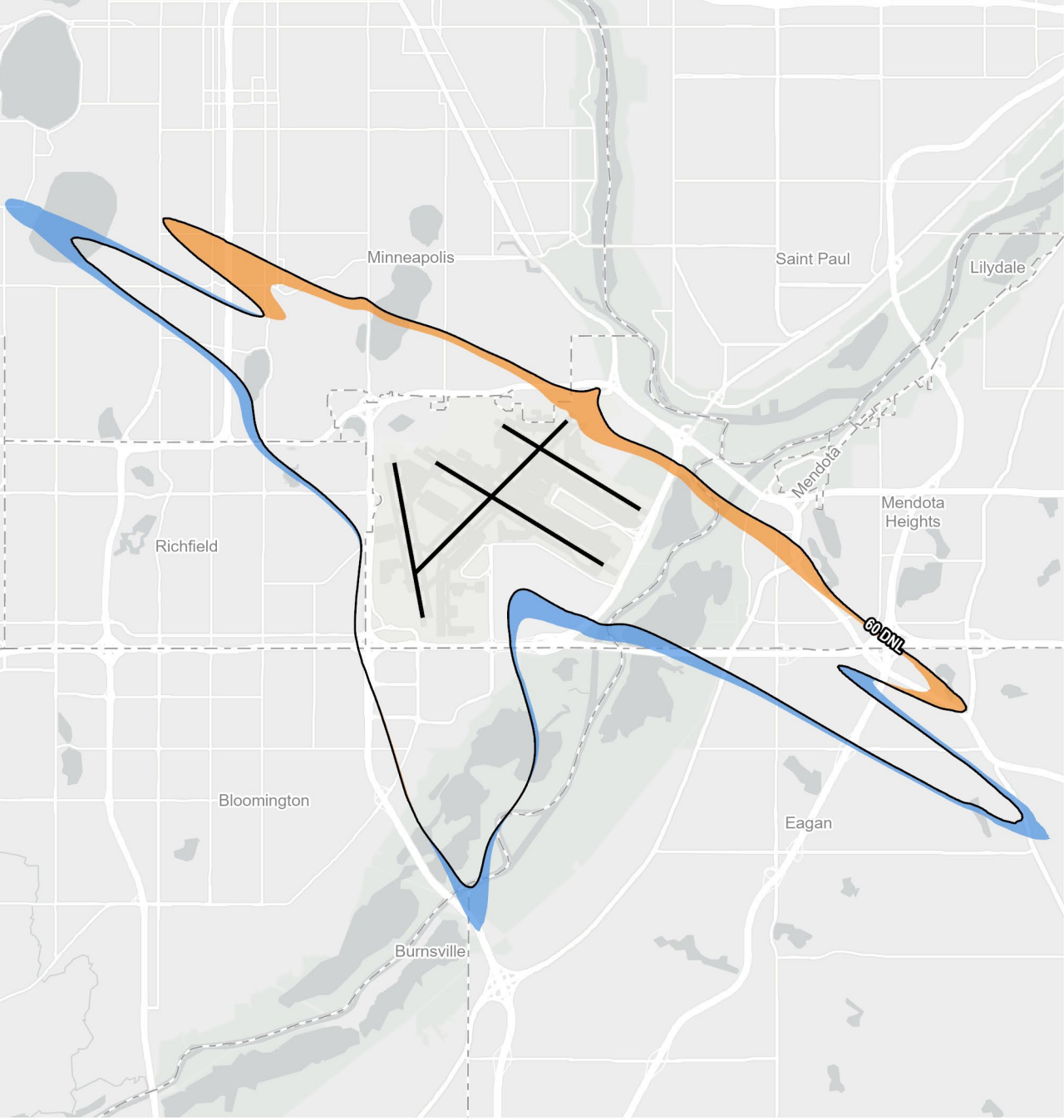

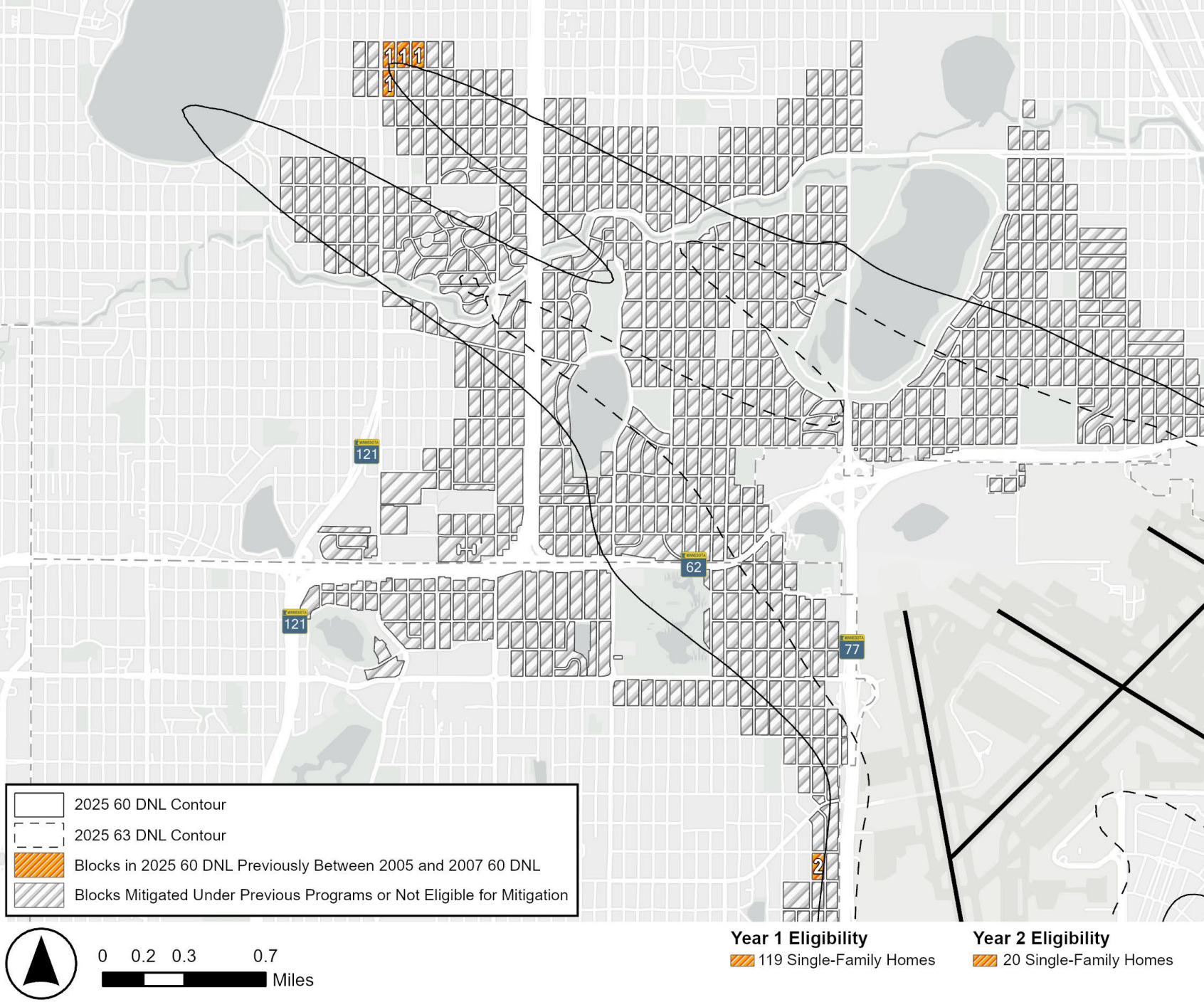
2025 – 2032 Program

- Eligibility based on Actual Noise Contour
- A home will become eligible for residential noise mitigation if it
 - is located in the actual **60-64 dB DNL** contour for **3 consecutive years**,
 - and is in a higher noise impact mitigation area than previous programs
 - achieves first year of eligibility no later than **2028**
- Commits the MAC to provide noise mitigation until the year **2032**



2025 – 2032 Program Eligibility

- **119** single-family homes in the City of **Minneapolis** achieved the **first year of eligibility**
- **20** single-family homes in the City of **Richfield** achieved the **second year of eligibility**
- If these homes remain in a higher noise impact area compared to previous programs for **three consecutive years**, they will become **eligible** to receive mitigation in the 2025-2032 Program.
