Runway pavement and other maintenance work starting this summer will result in runway closures at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport (MSP) in 2024 and 2025. More information about this project is provided below.

MSP Airport has over 32 miles of runways and taxiways. It is critical to maintain airfield infrastructure for the safety of aircraft operations.

At times, airport construction and maintenance impact typical runway use. These activities may require temporary closures of runways at MSP to ensure the safety of construction crews and aircraft. Additionally, construction activities can impact how the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) assigns aircraft to open runways.

What construction activities are occurring?

During the summers of 2024 and 2025, runway and taxiway closures at MSP are planned to complete needed pavement work and runway safety area grading. This work is necessary to ensure critical airport infrastructure maintains the highest level of safety for handling aircraft operations

MSP Airport Long-Term Plan Overview



• The Plan is:

- A forward-looking planning tool that studies facility and infrastructure needs based on projected 20-year passenger demand and aircraft operations.
- It will focus on evaluating when facility improvements are needed to accommodate projected demand in a manner that is safe, efficient, orderly and cost-effective and that maintains and enhances customer service.

• The Plan does not:

- Authorize construction or improvements to facilities.
- Serve as a basis for determining eligibility for noise mitigation programs.

MSP Airport Long-Term Plan Objectives



 Objective #1: Plan for future facilities that will meet forecast Planning Activity Levels in a manner that maintains and enhances customer service, while facilitating a seamless "one-journey" experience

 Objective #2: Produce a development plan that positions the MAC to meet future demand levels, enhances financial strength, leverages environmental stewardship, and infuses sustainable thinking

Objective #3: Conduct the planning process in a manner that includes meaningful stakeholder engagement
