# **3.1 – ESTABLISHMENT OF RNAV PROCEDURE REVIEW SUB-COMMITTEE**





### **Establishment of RNAV Procedure Review Sub-Committee**

Per Article IX of NOC Bylaws:

- Sub-Committees can be established as needed.
- Sub-Committees shall be provided a defined task to accomplish:
  - Review proposed RNAV procedures for MSP.
  - Review impacts of proposed RNAV procedures for MSP.
  - Review FAA's engagement plan.
- Sub-Committees are provided a timeframe within which to complete the task.
  - The Sub-Committee will remain effective until the MSP VOR is decommissioned, and new departure procedures have been charted or until December 31, 2025, whichever is later.
- The composition of Sub-Committees will always be an equal balance of airport user and community representatives.
  - User Members
    - User Co-Chair
    - Chief Pilot representative
    - Scheduled airline representative

- Community Members
  - Community Co-Chair
  - City of Minneapolis representative
  - City of Eagan representative

# **CRO Update**

- The current test has been extended through March 3rd, 2023.
  - Lack of demand/traffic volume, weather variables, and fleet mix have limited the number of opportunities to be on the configuration.
  - The Workgroup is seeking more data to properly review the change in procedures.
  - The FAA is looking for more opportunities to train the workforce on the procedures.



# **Converging Runway Operations**

# • August 2023

- MSP was in a Runway 30/35 configuration 11% of the time, or approximately 54 hours.
- Aircraft actually landed on runway 35 less than 2% of the time, or approximately 10 hours.
- These numbers are consistent with 30/35 use in the month of July.

# **Working Group Overview**

- Collaborative process between the FAA, MAC, and Industry to develop a preliminary design that enhances safety and efficiency at MSP, while taking public interests into account
  - FAA
    - Local Air Traffic (MSP Tower, TRACON, ARTCC)
    - FAA Operations Support Group
    - Great Lakes Regional Administrator's Office
  - MAC: Represents community interests
  - Industry: Provides the users' preferred designs and evaluates the flyability of the procedures

# Approach

- Enhance safety and efficiency
- Modernize the National Airspace System (NAS)
  - Reduces complexity
    - Aircraft will know the flight path they will fly prior to leaving the gate
    - Enhances safety due to a reduction in communication between pilots and air traffic control
  - De-conflicts operations between satellite airports and airspace
- Leverage existing noise abatement practices



# **Status**

- Preliminary Project Design Completed (August 2023)
  - Developed New RNAV departure procedures to support the discontinuance of the MSP VOR and to comply with current FAA criteria
  - The procedures workgroup considered and incorporated the community interests and requests as represented by the MAC to the maximum extent possible.
