A. Long-Term Comprehensive Plan Update – Eric Gilles

Eric Gilles, MAC gave an update on the Long-Term Comp Plans. The LTCP process consists of holding public meetings, public comment period, review by Met Council, MAC Commission approval and environmental plan.

- Flying Cloud Airport, a LTCP preferred alternative map has been selected.
- St. Paul Downtown Airport, the LTCP engagement will commence before Summer.
- Anoka County/Blaine Airport, MAC is in the process of selecting a consultant to do the LTCP.
