ARTICLE VI

Voting Rights of Membership

- (1) At all meetings of the Council, attendance by two (2) <u>USER REPRESENTATIVES, one (1) PUBLIC</u> <u>REPRESENTATIVE and one (1) GOVERNMENT</u> <u>REPRESENTATIVE</u>, shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of business.
- (2) Each <u>USER, PUBLIC and GOVERNMENT</u> <u>REPRESENTATIVE</u>, or their appointed alternate, shall have one (1) vote.
- (1) Voting may be conducted via email, or by members in attendance at a meeting in-person or through use of virtual collaboration tool.
- (2) These Bylaws may be amended or altered by majority vote of membership provided that notice of such proposed amendments shall have been given ten (10) days prior to a general membership meeting.

ARTICLE VII

Chairperson of the Council

The representatives shall by majority vote of the membership present at the time of voting (in-person or through virtual collaboration tool) elect from amongst the constituency of the Council a Chairperson who shall serve for a two (2) year term or until their representation on the Council terminates, whichever occurs first; and until their successor is elected. The powers and duties of the Chairperson are as follows: The powers and duties of the Chairperson are as follows:

(1) To preside at all meetings of the Council.

- (2) To call special meetings of the Council as he/she deems necessary, or upon request by any three (3) USER, or two (2) PUBLIC, or one (1) GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE(S).
- (3) To sign as Chairperson of this Council, with the approval of the membership, certifications and other papers and instruments in-writing that may require such signature.
- (4) To form a Sub-committee as necessary, and appoint its members, for special projects.

To perform such other duties and tasks as these Bylaws or as the membership shall from time to time prescribe.

Nominations and Election for Chair

- Any member may be nominated
- One vote per member
- Each member will be called on to state their nomination
- At the end of nominations, nominated members have the option to decline

ARTICLE VIII

Vice-Chairperson

The representatives shall by majority vote of the membership present at the time of voting (in-person or through virtual collaboration tool) elect from amongst the constituency of the Council a Vice-Chairperson who shall serve for a two (2) year term or until their representation on the Council terminates, whichever occurs first; and until their successor is elected. The powers and duties of the Vice-Chairperson in the absence of the Chairperson are as follows:

(1) To preside at meetings of the Council.

(2) To call meetings.

(3) To perform the duties and exercise the powers of the Chairperson.

Nominations and Election for Vice Chair

- Any member may be nominated for Vice Chair, except the newly-elected Chair
- One vote per member
- Each member will be called on to state their nomination
- At the end of nominations, nominated members have the option to decline

STP Sound Study August 7-13, 2020

- The purpose of the study is to measure sounds associated with aircraft activity at St. Paul Downtown Airport (STP)
- MAC conducts an annual study in accordance with the commitments of the Supplemental Conditions of Agreement for the airport floodwall
- Each study involves seven consecutive days of field measurements
- Studies have been conducted each year since 2007
- Other studies in August were conducted in 2017 & 2010
- Modeling data were included in 2020 study
